OVERSEAS WINE PRODUCER OF THE YEAR – 2007 MUNDUS VINI INTERNATIONAL WINE AWARDS

Shingleback was named this week as the “Overseas Producer of the Year “ at the 2007 Mundus Vini International Wine Awards in Germany. Mundus Vini is the most important wine competition in Germany. This year 4925 wines from 35 countries greeted the judges.

Shingleback won 6 Gold Medals, led by the 2005 D Block McLaren Vale Cabernet Sauvignon, which also captured the Jimmy Watson Trophy at last years’ Royal Melbourne Wine Show. The other 5 golds went to the 2004 & 2005 D Block Shiraz, the 2004 D Block Cabernet Sauvignon and the 2005 Shingleback Show Reserve Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon.

John Davey (co- owner and winemaker) was elated “ For Shingleback and McLaren Vale to win this award is a great testament to what we do and to the uniqueness of our region. This win follows our nomination in London last year for the IWSC’s “Australian Producer of the Year”, and a succession of awards which include earning a 5 star rating from James Halliday.”

Managing Director, Kym Davey added, “This type of recognition is vital in maintaining Australia’s pre-eminent position in what is an increasingly competitive wine industry. For a medium sized family owned business to achieve such an award is a great boost for our distributors and supporting retailers and restaurateurs.”

Shingleback’s estate grown, rich, fruit forward wines are exported to the USA, Canada, UK, New Zealand, Europe, Scandinavia and Asia.
